1 How to Green Your Business

There is a growing interest among small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) wanting to green their business, but real action is slow as they usually lack the knowledge and resources to do so.

This workshop introduces four easy ways to help SME owners take the first steps towards creating a more sustainable company by looking at how to reduce risks, reduce costs, increase revenue, and enhance branding.

Duration: 3 hours

Target audience: Company employees

Group size: Minimum 5 people and maximum 30 people

2 Implementing an Eco-Office Programme

This workshop introduces the steps and tips for implementing an eco-office programme, including conducting an environmental audit; planning an environmental policy; and addressing various environmental aspects such as energy and water consumption and waste generated in the office.

Duration: 3 hours

Target audience: Company employees

Group size: Minimum 5 people and maximum 30 people

3 Organising Sustainable Events

This workshop introduces the steps and tips for organising a sustainable event, including addressing the sustainability aspects of the event organiser, venue, food and beverage, transportation, event materials and audio visual.

Duration: 3 hours

Target audience: Event and conference organisers

Group size: Minimum 5 people and maximum 30 people

4 Engaging Employees in CSR

This workshop introduces a framework that enables organisations to make their workplaces and operations more environmentally and socially responsible, by engaging their employees in this process.

The focus is more on emphasising how behaviour change can be brought about in people towards sustainability, and highlighting the context and conditions that enable such behaviour change.

Duration: 3 hours

Target audience: Company employees

Group size: Minimum 5 people and maximum 30 people

5 ISO14001 Environmental Management System

This workshop aims to equip participants with an overview of the ISO14001 Environmental Management System (EMS), a framework that helps company to reduce its environmental impacts and increase its operating efficiency.

Upon completion, participants would be able to describe the purpose and requirements of ISO14001, have a general understanding of the local legislation pertaining to environmental management, and construct a roadmap towards implementing EMS at their organisation.

Duration: 1 day (0900 to 1700)

Target audience: Company employees

Group size: Minimum 8 people and maximum 20 people

6 Environmental Aspects and Impacts

This workshop aims to enable participants to identify and evaluate environmental aspects and impacts, a process that is critical in the planning stage of ISO14001 EMS.

Upon completion, participants would be able to distinguish between environmental aspects and impacts, describe the process, and most importantly, apply the process to identify and evaluate environmental aspects and impacts within the scope of their organisation's EMS.

Duration: 1 day (0900 to 1700)

Target audience: Company employees

Group size: Minimum 8 people and maximum 20 people

7 Environmental, Health and Safety Laws in Singapore

This workshop aims to provide participants with an overview of the environmental, health and safety (EHS) laws in Singapore. It focuses on basic pollution laws relating to air, water, waste, hazardous substances, noise and nature conservation, as well as personnel health and safety at work.

Upon completion, participants would have an understanding of the local legislative framework and the current EHS legislation, and be able to relate these requirements to the EHS management system of their organisations. Participants would also understand how compliance to the legislation can be achieved.

Duration: 1 day (0900 to 1700)

Target audience: Company employees

Group size: Minimum 8 people and maximum 20 people

WORKSHOPS

8 Upcycling of Waste Material into Useful Items

This hands-on workshop allows participants to make useful items from waste recyclable materials. Choose from one of the following items:

- T-shirt Bag - make a reusable tote bag from old t-shirts
- Photo Frame made from drink cartons
- Eco Jewelry - make jewelry from old t-shirts and plastic bottles
- Eco Jewelry - use macramé to create a necklace from old t-shirts
- Mini Slippers made from t-shirts
- T-Shirt Belt - make a belt from old t-shirts
- Bottle Cap Magnets/Charms
- Plastic Bottle Lampshade

Duration: 1.5 to 3 hours

Target audience: Company and organisation employees; School or public participants

Group size: Minimum 20 people and maximum 40 people

9 Lamp Making from Unwanted Wooden Pallets

This hands-on workshop allows participants to design and make a lamp using unwanted wooden pallets. Participants will learn to work with wood using saws and drills, and wire a lighting circuit.

Duration: 3 hours

Target audience: Company and organisation employees (12 years and above)

Group size: Minimum 25 people

WORKSHOPS

10 Making Glass Decorations from Unwanted Glass Bottles

This hands-on workshop allows participants to design and make glass decorations such as decorative lights and bells using unwanted glass bottles. Participants will try cutting glass, etching and using adhesives.

Duration: 2 hours

Target audience: Company and organisation employees (12 years and above)

Group size: Minimum 15 people

1 Waste Management and Recycling

The tour will start with an introduction to waste management and recycling in Singapore, followed by a visit to an incineration plant, the offshore Semakau landfill or to a recycling plant.

2 Green Buildings

The tour will start with an introduction to green buildings in Singapore, followed by a visit to a Green Mark certified building or to a Zero Energy Building.

3 Water Management

The tour will start with an introduction to water management policies in Singapore, followed by a visit to a NEWater plant or to the Marina Barrage.

4 Energy and Climate Change

The tour will start with an introduction to energy and climate change policies in Singapore, followed by a visit to a Zero Energy Building.

5 Nature and Biodiversity

The tour will include a guided walk through a nature area in Singapore (such as Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve or Chek Jawa) with introduction to the biodiversity found along the walk.
